

How to Make Your Own StillClean Stand

A StillClean stand is desirable if you don't have a convenient place to set your StillClean. In addition, if you use your StillClean on two or more parts cleaners, a stand with wheels would make the task of moving your StillClean from machine to machine much easier. A stand can also be designed to incorporate an oil container that the StillClean can empty into, reducing the number of trips you need to make from your StillClean to your used oil tank. Simply follow these instructions to make your own stand that will accomplish all of these goals while being easy and inexpensive.

1. First find a 30-gallon drum to dedicate to the project. The drum should be in good shape as it will serve as both your machine's stand and oil container. Label the drum "Used Oil".



2. Next take a 2" hole saw and drill a hole in the lid of the drum. The hole should be positioned directly below the drain spout on your StillClean when it is sitting on the drum.

3. Finally, find or purchase a drum dolly. The one we used costs about \$50 and can be ordered directly from Grainger, item: 2W269
